5. Selection Committee

The scholarship is to be awarded by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendation of a selection committee, which shall comprise

- a) The Convenor of the Scholarships Committee or nominee, and
- b) The Assistant Vice-Chancellor, M ori and Pasifika or nominee, and
- c) A member of the Carroll Whanau or nominee.

The selection committee will invite short listed candidates to attend an interview.

The selection committee may refrain from making an award if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.

- 6. Tenure
 - a) The tenure of the scholarship is for one academic year.
 - b) Previous recipients may apply for a continuing scholarship.
 - c) The scholarship is tenable with any other scholarship, award or bursary that is not funded by Lincoln University.
- 7. Reviews of Progress
 - a) A scholar is expected to have fully participated in the key aspects of the Sir Turi Carroll Centennial Scholarship. They are:
 - 1) Pass eight courses towards a Bachelor degree programme with a minimum of a 5.0 Grade Point Average (B Grade), and
 - 2) Contribute positively to Te Awhioraki, the M ori Student Association at Lincoln University.
 - c) If the Vice-Chancellor, at any time, is satisfied that the scholar is not diligently pursuing his or her studies; or is not complying with the conditi
